The recent financial upheavals at Commander have taken their toll on the company's employees with about a quarter of 2,000 staff being shed since it struck financial difficulties last year.

The Union representing the technical employees, the CEPU, is concerned that employees' entitlements must be protected.

The Divisional Secretary, Burt Blackburne said today. "We have been in contact with the company regarding the future of our members many of whom are long term employees with the company and have carried over entitlements from their former employer Telstra."
